MEAL DEAL LAUNCH— Starts next Monday

The Nutrition Team in conjunction with SRC have devised a promotion where students can receive reward if they purchase a full meal from the Canteen. It is called a Meal Deal.

What is so special about the Meal Deal?

The Canteen Price list has been updated so that students can select a healthy 'green' rated lunch, drink and snack. The healthy 'green' foods have an asterix next to them. When a student selects an asterix food (*) from the lunch, drink and snack sections they will be eligible for a stamp on their Meal Deal (MD) Card. On Special Healthy food days these foods can be used as an option in the Meal Deals.

Every student will have a MD Card which will be kept in the Canteen. Ten stamps and the student will receive the card back and will have \$3 of 'Canteen' money to spend at the Canteen. Students will submit their card at the canteen and the amount spent will be deducted from their card

How will the students order?

They will order like they have done so in the past except they must insert a 'Meal Deal Order Slip' into their order bag. On this slip will be information our Canteen Helpers will use to process the Meal Deal and advise you (when the slip is returned) an update total of Meal Deals purchased. Many of the foods sold in the Canteen are 'green' rated by the NSW Healthy Canteens Association. It is the Canteen's aim to increase this list of options. By supporting the Canteen not only will the students be eating healthier options but they will be rewarded for their participation.
